Dear Community Member

As you may be aware, our combined heat and power recovery unit - Cogen - has been required to shut down and restart more frequently than planned leading to regretted periods of noise disruption for our local communities.

To improve the unit reliability we are undertaking a major programme of work to service and upgrade the unit this summer. Critically, we will be installing a new silencer which is designed to lower noise associated with unit operations, and most significantly through unit shut-down and re-starts.

To allow our team to begin this work, we plan to safely shut down the Cogen down during the day on Wednesday 1 June.

If you live in the immediate surrounding area, you may hear a short period of noise but we are taking steps to minimise this wherever possible.

We currently anticipate re-starting the unit, following completion of the work, towards the end of July. We will provide you with further updates in advance.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we undertake these improvements.
